

Overview of Seven Potatoes (Organization)

The Central Vancouver Island Japanese-Canadian Cultural Society (CVIJCCS), also known as 7 Potatoes, is a non-profit organization. We celebrate Japanese heritage by providing social and cultural activities extending into the central Vancouver Island area. There are approximately 60 families who are members. We publish a newsletter and have a website and a Facebook page. The society offers about 6-8 activities and events per year. The activities and events include Shinnenkai, Sushi Lunch, Ramen/Udon Lunch, Tanabata Festival, Themed Potlucks, Spring Picnic, Japanese Movie Days, Odori, Taiko, Cherry Blossom Planting Project, Softball, and other activities.
